Leaders from the group are now committed to continuing the movement that one of the martyrs helped start. Pray for strength, protection, and multiplication.*

*"Praise God for the courageous wife of one martyr, who forgave community elders when they came to offer 16 cattle as blood compensation. She declined the offer because of a dream the night before, in which her husband told her not to accept it. Pray that God provides for her and uses her as a witness of His forgiveness and goodness."*
